Village Signs

It was reported that Lincolnshire County Highways need to consent to any structure being placed on verges. This being the position, a decision was taken to consult with Lincs CC regarding any possible further costs being incurred, prior to accepting the quotation from JACS for 6 gateway structures.

Fosse Green Energy

An application for a large 'Solar Panel Farm' extending to over 1000 hectares including parts of the parish was lodged by Fosse Green Energy in late June. A meeting in Witham St Hughes took place on 11th July attended by County, District and local Parish Councillors to discuss this and

other similar applications in the County. A submission from the Parish has been sent to the Government Department from which the application was received, outlining our concerns.

Fosse Green Energy have stated that consultations with the local community will commence this autumn.

Financial Report.

As at 29/06/2023 funds in the Community account stood at £4303.19 having made payments of £817.14 since the last meeting. CIL Income of £39.27 was received in early June. Funds held in the Skipton Building Society as at 10/07/2023 were £8324.08. The interest rate had recently been increased to 3.25%.
